Well-Check is a water testing package designed to test your well water for bacteria (Total Coliform and E-Coli), 22 heavy metals and minerals (including lead, arsenic and mercury), 7 inorganic chemicals (including nitrates and chloride) and 5 physical factors that include pH, alkalinity and hardness. This is an excellent package for anyone interested in regularly monitoring their well water quality or if you are trying to determine if a filtration or softening system is required.

Watercheck 1&2

Watercheck 1&2 tests well water and city water for 22 heavy metals and minerals (including lead, arsenic and mercury), 7 inorganic chemicals (including nitrates and chloride) and 5 physical factors that include pH, alkalinity and hardness. This is an excellent package for anyone interested in determining if a treatment system might be required or if an existing filtration or softening system is working properly.

Watercheck

Watercheck tests for a total of 87 items including bacteria (Total Coliform and E-Coli), 22 heavy metals and minerals (including lead, arsenic and mercury), 7 inorganic chemicals (including nitrates and chloride), 5 physical factors (including pH, alkalinity and hardness), 4 trihalomethanes (disinfection by-products) and 47 volatile organic chemicals (including MTBE, PCE and TCE). This is an excellent package for anyone who has never tested their well water or who have not tested in several years. This test package is considered to be very comprehensive and is useful in determining if a treatment system is needed for your well water.

Watercheck with Pesticide Option

Watercheck with Pesticide Option tests for a total of 107 items including bacteria (Total Coliform and E-Coli), 22 heavy metals and minerals (including lead, arsenic and mercury), 7 inorganic chemicals (including nitrates and chloride), 5 physical factors (including pH, alkalinity and hardness), 4 trihalomethanes (disinfection by-products), 47 volatile organic chemicals (including MTBE, PCE and TCE) and 20 pesticides, herbicides and PCBs (including Dieldrin, Atrazine and Heptachlor). This is an excellent package for anyone who has never tested their well water or who have not tested in several years and are concerned about potential pesticide contamination. This test package is considered to be very comprehensive and is useful in determining if a treatment system is needed for your well water.
